### **COUNTRYSIDE TOUR (3.5 Hours)**

Drive through the suburb of KL. Observe the local way of life and their traditional cottage industries.

Admire the skills of the artisans at the renowned Royal Selangor Pewter Factory, the largest Pewter Factory in the world. See how batik is made and shop for some souvenirs. Then proceed to Batu Caves.

## **CULTURAL NIGHT TOUR (4 Hours)**

"Garden City of Lights" offers eye catching Malaysia's potpourri of cultures. Try your bargaining skills at the night market in Chinatown. Enjoy the local buffet

**Orchid Garden** - see over 800 varieties of orchid including the exotic species, thrive abundantly on one hectare of floral paradise.

The Deer Park - located on the undulating slopes and sprawling valley of the Lake Gardens. Close to a bubbling stream at the edge of the valley are several mousedeer. The mousedeer is the world's smallest hoofed animal and a popular subject in local folklore due to its legendary wittiness.

The Butterfly Park - houses some 6,000 butterflies of over 120 species. The park is an imitation of the butterfly's natural habitat. It includes more than 15,000 plants from 100 species that have been used to recreate a Malaysian rainforest atmosphere.

**Kuala Lumpur Bird Park** - the largest bird park in South East Asia, houses thousands of birds representing nearly every major species in this part of the world.

#### **SUNWAY LAGOON TOUR (6 Hours)**

Standing beside Dataran Putra and facing the Putrajaya Lake, it incorporates architectural elements from Turkestan, Kazakhstan and Morocco. Another eye-catching building is the Prime Minister's office - **Putra Perdana**. Other interesting places are **Putra Bridge**, **Prime Minister's residence**.
